Shake

Approx. 1.5 spray coats until an even glossy surface is created.

Optimum application at 64° F - 77° F (18° C - 25° C) and a relative humidity from 40 - 50 %.

Continue

Evaporates without leaving any residues after approx. 60 minutes. Can be wiped with a cloth.

Finish



After painting, turn the can upside down and spray the valve until empty.

UV blockers in the clearcoat can cause differences in colour tone for certain colours compared to the use of Surface Control Spray. We therefore recommend subsequent control with the corresponding clearcoat in these cases.

Shelf Life



60 months
