DIRECTIONS:

SHAKE WELL before using. Apply Complete Glaze to surface with a wax applicator pad. Let product dry to a haze. Polish off with a clean, microfiber cloth. Entire vehicle may be treated before wiping off. For best results, apply on a cool surface and out of direct sunlight.

PRODUCT FAQ'S:

Q1: Is Ultra Complete Glaze™ (Complete Glaze) body shop safe?

A1: Complete Glaze contains no silicones and should be 100% body shop safe as long as product is used as directed.

Q2: Will Complete Glaze work on fresh paint?

A2: Yes, Complete Glaze will not seal fresh paint or cause solvent pop.

Q3: How quickly should the product be removed after application?

A3: Complete Glaze is unlike a carnauba wax. It can be applied to the entire vehicle before beginning removal if desired.

Q4: How do I know when the product is ready to be removed?

A4: Complete Glaze will only haze slightly. Product will sufficiently flash in approximately 3 – 5 minutes under normal weather conditions. It does not turn chalky like a carnauba wax and will not produce white dust when being removed.

Q5: Can Complete Glaze be applied with a rotary buffer?

A5: The product works best if applied by hand but if a technician is used to applying or removing with a rotary buffer it could be done at a slow speed, 1000 rpms or less, with the Presta Soft White Foam Pad (#890155).

Q6: Does Complete Glaze help protect my paint?

A6: Complete Glaze will provide up to 30 days of paint protection in optimal conditions.
